Bells of Peace

There is a bell monument between the landing stage at the Welcome Hotel and the rowing club. The so-called "bells of peace" were cast from the heads of air raid bombs from the Second World War. When they are struck, they ring out over the entire Lake Henne.



EMS Hennesee

important INFORMATION on the QUAGGAMUSCHEL

 The aim is to prevent the spread of the invasive quagga mussel. Rules for preventing the spread of the quagga mussel: Essentially, boats without a jetty berth are no longer permitted on Lake Hennesee. There are very specific cleaning instructions for water sports equipment (emptying, high-pressure washing, optional disinfection, thorough drying). The use of inflatable boats, SUPs not hired from the local rental service and swimming toys is prohibited. Floating aids may be used provided they have been cleaned.
